ORDER

Before the Court is the parties' Joint Status Report [Dkt. No. 1424], in which they have proposed that the jury trial of this action commence on April 15, 2024. Plaintiffs submit that a two-week trial is "more than necessary to try this case" and request a "timed trial" with "equal time allotted to each party" to preserve court resources. <u>Id.</u> at 2, 4. Defendant objects to a time limit for presentation, noting that the Court "is well able to manage its courtroom" and "take steps to avoid inefficient and/or unduly cumulative presentation of evidence." <u>Id.</u> at 11. Having reviewed the parties' positions and finding good cause for defendant's objection, it is hereby

ORDERED that the jury trial in this civil action be and is SCHEDULED to begin on Monday, April 15, 2024 at 10:00 a.m. Although the Court does not expect the trial to last three weeks and will make every effort to have this action tried within two weeks, it will not use any timing mechanisms to limit each party's time to present evidence, unless it appears a party is not presenting its case efficiently.
